EuroMouse European collaboration in mouse functional genomics research

The EuroMouse conference (Venice, 14th and 15th October 2005), brought together many of the mouse functional genomics consortia for the first time. It was clear that there is a wide coverage of diseases and biological systems being investigated under these projects. This was a good opportunity to advertise the large-scale mouse functional genomics projects (EMMA, EUMORPHIA and EUCOMM). As a result of this benchmarking exercise, PRIME has produced A5 fliers of many of these projects. These will be included in a booklet outlining the benefits of mouse functional genomics research to human health research see report for Deliverable 06 (mouse brochure). We will continue to produce fliers for new projects.

PRIME position paper

As part of the benchmarking exercise, we have produced an updated version of the PRIME position paper. This is an ongoing process and the paper is being refined as PRIME progresses.
